These prayers/ intercessory will be done during Sunday Services, Morning Glory, Morning Devotion and Evening Fellowships. Prayers will be done two or more according to the time of the concerned session.

- Thanks to God for the protection of our country from different calamities including Covid-19 pandemic. God has protected us until now from Covid-19 pandemic. (Reading Word for this prayer is Psalm 124:1-8).
- 2. Thanks to God for the Presedent John Magufuli who ordered Tanzanians to fight against Covid-19 pandemic by starting with Worship to God. President Magufuli believes that God is above all things including science and technology. Thus, we have first to seek help from the Almighty God, the source of everything. (2Chronicles 20:2-4).
- 3. Praying to God for the repentance on what we have sinned against God in which cause us to suffer from this Covid-19 pandemic. (Reading Word: 2Chronicles 7:13-14).
- 4. Praying for all leaders who assist Presidents from all levels of leadership so that they may be united to lead their countries by God's wisdom during this pandemic period. (Reading Word: 1Chronicles 12:17-18).
- 5. Praying for all religious leaders to have commitment on intercessory for their countries against Covid-19 and encouraging people to trust on God in this pandemic period without neglecting necessary health restrictions against corona virus. (Reading Word: Ezekiel 22:30).
